IMPORTANT FMO INFORMATION

The FMO was created in the 60's to promote the general welfare of its members and protect the rights and interests of manufactured home owners and to be a consumer advocate for manufactured home owners. Several years ago, the FMO had about 100,000 members. Today there are only 10,000 members. Without an increase in membership the FMO will be difficult to survive. The biggest reason for this reduction is a lack of interest and understanding of the FMO. The biggest accomplishment to date of the FMO occurred several years ago when Florida was considering to ad sales tax to our monthly lease amount at the rate of 6.5%. The FMO vigorously fought this and thankfully this did not become a law. Florida could again bring this up at any time. To prevent this from going into effect now is the time for all our residents to join the FMO. Should Florida tax our monthly lot rental payment to include a 6.5% sales tax to our monthly lot rental could go up 11.5% the first year this goes into effect (5% from Sun plus 6.5% sales tax). Another important FMO accomplishment is the tie down program. This program has provided one million dollars from the state of Florida in 2025 to pay the cost of contractors to inspect the tie downs and bring the tie downs up to current code. I will provide additional information at a future date. The annual cost for membership in the FMO is only \$40.00 per year. Membership applications are available online at www.fmo.org and on the HOA website. I also bring extra applications to the HOA monthly meetings. HOME MAINTENANCE AND SAFETY TIPS SUMMER AND LAWN IRRIGATION

During the summer months, we are restricted on how often, and when, lawn irrigation can take place. This is governed by Volusia County. During Daylight Savings Time, watering is allowed from 4 PM until 10 AM only. Odd numbered addresses can water on Wednesdays and Saturdays, and even addresses can water on Thursdays and Sundays. This applies for all sources of water, wells, public utilities, or ponds. Watering is allowed for up to one hour and no more than $\frac{3}{4}$ of an inch per zone, per day. New plantings may be watered anytime for up to 30 days, and then every other day for 30 more days. Keep a receipt for the new plantings as proof of purchase, allowing the extra watering.

Irrigation systems do require maintenance. Check the operation of your system from time to time to ensure that all sprinkler heads are working properly and spraying water on the yard and not the street or driveway. If your system uses water from a well or pond, debris can clog sprinkler heads restricting water flow. Sprinkler heads positioned too low, can become covered by the grass over time preventing them from popping up and watering the yard. Sprinkler heads positioned too high, can become damaged by lawn equipment or vehicles for those positioned near the street or driveway.
